Entry confirmation

Entry confirmations will be send by email. If you have not received a confirmation one week prior to the show, please contact the Felikat show entry clerk as soon as possible. Entry confirmations will only be send after the original entry through your own club and the payment of the entry fees have been received, so please enter and pay at the same time!

Accommodation cat on show

Felikat no longer uses cages. Exhibitors must arrange the accommodation of the cat themselves. There is a table available for the accommodation, the size for this is per cat: 66 cm x 66 cm x 66 cm.
It is possible to borrow a sturdy from Felikat upon registration. These can be borrowed in limited quantities.

Vetting-in

From 7.30 until 8.30 hrs
It is obligatory for all entered cats to be vaccinated against rabies at least 21 days prior to the show, as well as against respiratory viral diseases and panleucopenia at least 14 days prior to the show. The type of vaccine used is decisive for the period of validity.

All cats coming from foreign countries must be provided with necessary documents according to EU regulation 2013. They have to be identified by either microchip or tattoo. Without entry confirmation, valid vaccinations or passport a cat will not be admitted to the exhibition hall.

All your cat's nails must be clipped. A cat with an ear or skin disorder or with characteristics of an infectious disease will be refused. The cat must be free of parasites (such as fleas and worms).
Pregnant or lactating cats are not allowed. White cats must have proof that they are hearing, white cats without this proof and deaf cats are not allowed.

Judging

From 9.00 until appr. 14.30 hrs
The exhibitor is requested to present the cat for judging to the judge.

Best in Show panel

Starting from appr. 15.30 hrs

End of exhibition

18.00 hrs or when the Best in show has been finished, whichever comes last.
